Noise bund construction and aggregate recycling Jersey Farm



Completed: June 2014

Objectives

- ▶ Secure planning permission for the extension of a noise bund at Jersey Farm, adjacent to Junction 27 of the M5 in the interest of mitigating noise emissions from the motorway for the nearby office developments.
- ▶ Obtain a bespoke environmental permit for the construction of the noise bund and continued operation of the site as a treatment and transfer operation for recycled aggregates.

Delivery

- ▶ Prepare and submit a planning application to Waste Planning Authority, Devon County Council
- ▶ Comprehensive consultation and negotiation with the Environment Agency.
- ▶ Agree a Waste Recovery Plan with the Environment Agency for the construction of the noise bund as a "Use of Waste for Construction" activity and consolidation of permits to cover all on-site recovery and off-site transfer activities.
